1. The Annual General Assembly was held in a hybrid format via Zoom and in Room C-CR6 at the Vienna International Centre. The Chair, Ian Tennant, welcomed the participants, while the Secretary, Yuliya Zabyelina, confirmed the accreditation and verified the quorum which was met at 11:30 Vienna time with 23 Ordinary Members. 2 Ordinary Members joined at a later stage.
2. The Chair introduced the Agenda and proposed its adoption. The Agenda was approved without changes.
3. The Chair introduced the minutes of the General Assembly held on 19 May 2025, which were approved by consensus.
4. The Chair reported on the activities of Alliance since the previous General Assembly, which took place on 19 May 2025. He detailed some of the important steps that were taken in the last year, such as the launch of the first ever civil society compendium, the involvement in regional preparatory meetings for the UN Crime Congress, the participation in CDs to UNTOC and in intergovernmental expert groups.

The Secretary reported on the informal meetings, website users, mailing lists, social media as well as YouTube presence. In the absence of the Treasurer (apologized), the Chair reported on the financial and membership activities of the Alliance, presenting a report on the Alliance's 2025 Budget as outlined in the documents sent to Members in preparation for the GA.

The reports of the Chair and Treasurer were approved.

5. The report from the Auditors was approved.
6. The financial report and the audited annual accounts were approved.
7. The president of the Nominations Committee Elisabeth Francis of Graduate Women International (GWI) presented the nominations report, which was approved.
8. The president of the elections committee, Christian Ponti of CROSS, presented the results of the election. Out of the 70 Ordinary Members who could vote, 36 voted. For the position of Vice-Chairs, Tariq Khosa (CGR) received 24 votes, Leah Conklin (ILF) received 19 votes, and Lisa Hartevelt (WJC) received 19 votes. For the position of Member of the Board Abdelgawad Ahmed Abdelhamid (ACSFT) received 19 votes, Jay Albanese (CWB) received 18 votes, Rosemary Barberet (ISA) received 21 votes and Jerome Mangelik (PRI) received 11 votes.
